Chip Cravaack's office would like to set up a temporary office in our town hall to answer questions from citizens on a Friday in December; possibly the 2, 9, or the 16. They will call again to set up the exact date.

The voluntary survey from the U.S. Census Bureau was received.

Old Business:

- Bloom Lake: There is no update at this time.
- There was discussion about selling the lot that the township owns. It was decided that more investigation is needed to give a fair price.
- Summons: discuss update at the next meeting.
- Four tires for the grader and the tractor were purchased.
- There was discussion with Stan about which road to gravel Panola or Quinlan Ave. It will cost approximately \$11,000 to fix 280th and approximately \$5,812 to fix Panola.
